Excerpt: ...Only a short time ago, the ability to localize tumors was so limited that the operation was undertaken with apprehension and uncertainty, while at the present time operation may be performed, with a reasonable certainty of finding the tumor and, in many instances, of removing it. Until very recently, the attention given operable conditions of the brain, especially tumors, was quite out of proportion to that devoted to corresponding lesions of the cord. Experience is proving that the cord is more favorable for surgical interference, the conditions to be relieved quite as distressing and the prospect of relief greater, since a larger proportion of spinal tumors are operable.
